Transportation to and from the two area airports

The major airports in the area are the Detroit International Airport (DTW-53 miles from Guest House) and the Flint Bishop International Airport (FNT-43 miles from Guest House). The Detroit International Airport will offer many more flight options than the Flint Bishop Airport. As neither of the two area airports contract with a major shuttle service, if you select the \$399 option above, Guest House will provide transportation to and from the airport. Rokelle Lerner is the Senior Clinical Advisor at Crossroads Recovery Center in Antigua. She is an internationally known speaker and trainer in the areas of family dysfunction, trauma, and narcissism. Rokelle designs and presents workshops and seminars on addiction, recovery and relationship issues for both the public and private sectors. Her work has been honored by the National Association for Children of Alcoholics' Lifetime Achievement Award and Esquire Magazine's "Top 100 Women in the US Who Are Changing the Nation."

Rokelle has appeared on *Oprah*, *Good Morning America*, and *20/20*. She is an inspiring and deeply caring individual who can address difficult topics with expertise, clarity, compassion, and humor.

Rokelle is regarded by peers as a leader in their field and has shared experiences with Claudia Black, Tian Dayton, Cynthia Moreno Tuohy, and Sharon Wegscheider-Cruise to name a few.

"Entitlement, Rage and Contempt: Narcissistic Wounds and the Challenge of Recovery (Strategies for Healing)"

Many addicts suffer from false pride, entitlement, and grandiosity that, unfortunately, don't disappear with sobriety. This narcissism interferes with personal and professional relationships that are so filled with conflict and pain that relapse often occurs. This day will examine the relational consequences of narcissism and offer tools to clinicians who recognize this destructive dynamic treatment and recovery:

- To explain the relationship between narcissism and addiction
- To explore the relational dynamics of recovering addicts/alcoholics
- To explain how narcissistic rage and anxiety trigger relapse
- To demonstrate tools that release narcissistic images and reduce conflict in relationships
