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GUEST HOUSE TO BREAK GROUND ON NEW HEALTH & WELLNESS CENTER EXPANSION

LAKE ORION, MI— Guest House, a national Catholic addiction treatment and recovery center for clergy and men and women religious, will break ground on its new Health & Wellness Center expansion on its historic Lake Orion campus. The project marks a major step forward in Guest House's 70-year mission to provide comprehensive care for those who serve the Church.

The new center will strengthen Guest House's holistic approach to treatment by expanding programs focused on wellness, nutrition, physical health, and spiritual renewal, and by supporting stronger long-term recovery outcomes. "This Health & Wellness Center is more than a building—it is a sign of our commitment to the lifelong well-being of those who serve the Church," said Jeff Henrich, President & CEO of Guest House. "Here, body, mind, and spirit will be cared for in ways that support lasting recovery."

The expansion adds a demonstration kitchen, dedicated fitness and wellness rooms, and flexible retreat and educational spaces for Church leadership, clergy, men and women religious, and seminarians, strengthening Guest House's integrated clinical and spiritual programming.

"For 70 years, Guest House has been a place of hope and healing for the Church," said Dr. Ray Demers, Chair of the Board of Trustees. "This new center ensures that those who come to us—now and in the future—have the resources they need to recover and continue their ministries with strength and stability."

The ceremony will include brief remarks, prayer, recognition of Church and civic partners, and a ceremonial groundbreaking with leaders from Guest House and the community.
