



## HEALTH & WELLNESS CENTER CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

### Update #1

We are pleased to share our first progress update on the new Guest House Health & Wellness Center—a transformational project that will expand access to modern wellness resources and strengthen our continuum of care for Catholic clergy, men and women religious, and seminarians seeking renewed health and life.

### Recent Progress

Early December marked several important milestones as construction officially got underway:

- **EarthCam Installation Complete**  
A live-view construction camera has been installed to safely monitor progress. Visitors can watch the project unfold at [guesthouse.org/health-wellness-center](http://guesthouse.org/health-wellness-center).
- **Safety & Site Protections in Place**  
Temporary fencing and erosion-control systems have been established to ensure a secure construction zone and preserve our surrounding environment.
- **Groundbreaking Celebration**  
On December 11, leaders, partners, and supporters joined us to commemorate the official start of this expansion. We are grateful to everyone who celebrated this historic moment with us.
- **Canopy Removal & Structural Prep**  
The canopy at the South Treatment Center entrance is being carefully dismantled. It will be repurposed onsite next year.

### What's Ahead

The next phase focuses on foundation and underground systems:

- Subsurface dewatering will continue until complete.
- Basement excavation and foundation work are scheduled to begin in early January.
- Initial vertical construction elements will follow shortly thereafter.
