Update #2

We are pleased to share our second progress update on the new Guest House Health & Wellness Center—a vital expansion that will deepen our ability to provide care for Catholic clergy, men and women religious, and seminarians seeking healing, renewal, and long-term wellness.

Recent Progress

Construction continues to advance steadily, with several important developments on site:

- **Temporary Roads Added for Safety & Access**
Temporary construction roads have been installed across campus to support heavy equipment movement and ensure clear, reliable access for construction and emergency vehicles throughout the project.
- **Canopy Removal Complete**
The canopy at the South Treatment Center entrance has been fully and successfully removed. As planned, it will be repurposed for future onsite use.
- **Subsurface Dewatering Underway**
Crews are actively engaged in subsurface dewatering to safely prepare the site for the next phase of construction.

What's Ahead

Work will continue to progress steadily in the coming weeks as we move through critical early construction phases:

- Crews will continue work on foundation and underground infrastructure as site conditions allow.
- Structural steel and precast concrete components are currently in production. Installation will begin once subsurface dewatering is complete and the site is fully prepared.
